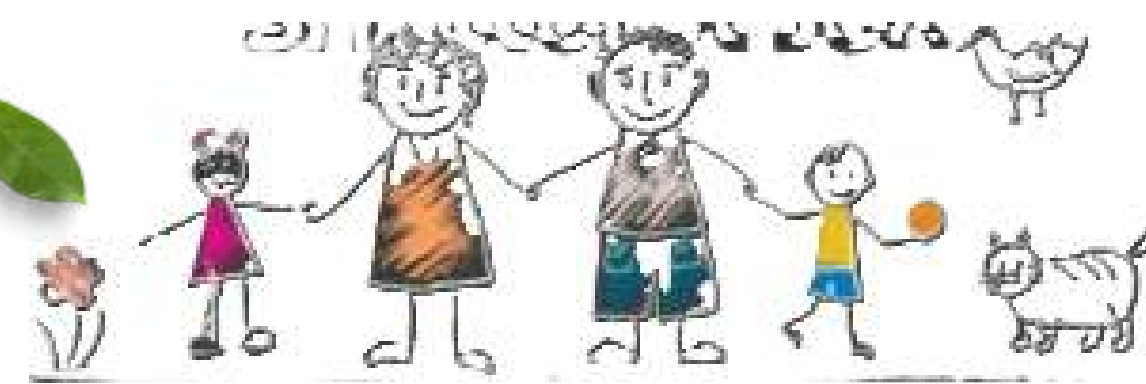

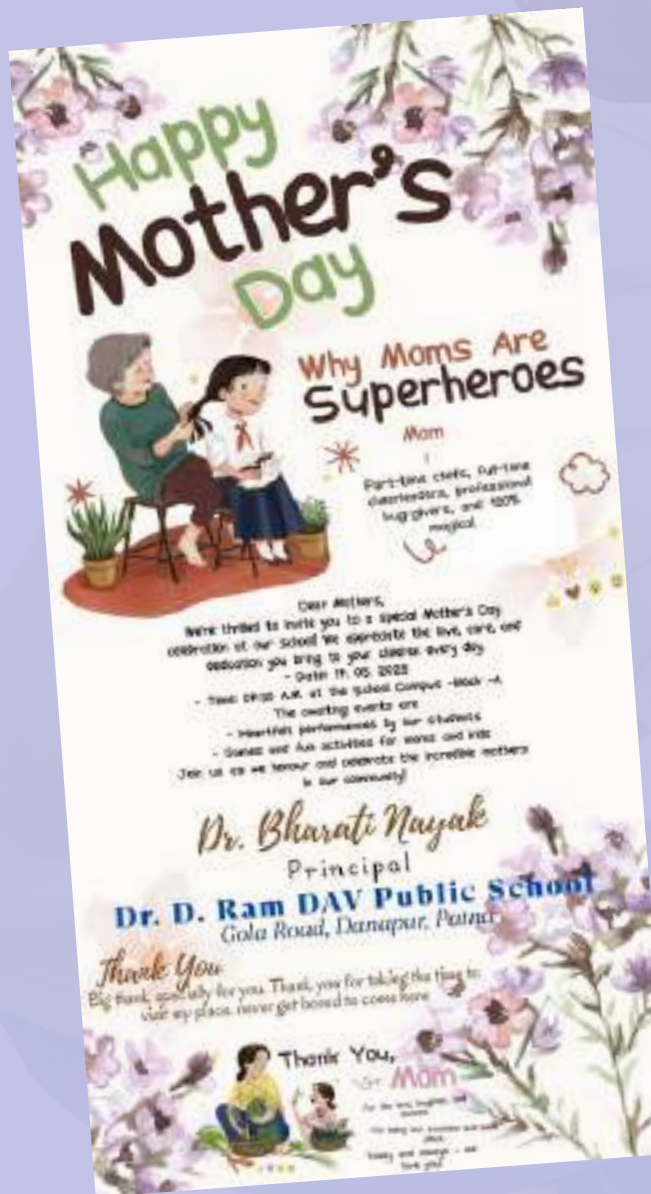

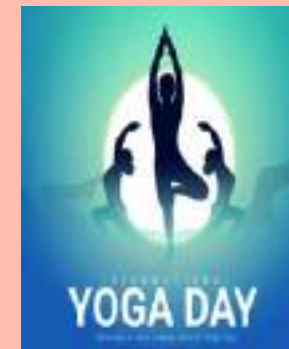
## International Yoga Day

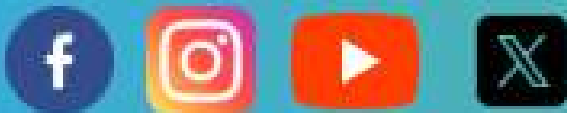
